

WHAT IS GRANPARENT MENTORSHIP?

Scripture has detailed what to do as an elder:

Titus: Chapter 2:

2. That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in faith, in charity, in patience.

3 The aged women likewise, that *they be* in behaviour as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things;

The Seven Teachings:

Mentorship for parents from a family perspective:

Assist with family meetings; sharing circle;

Be a regular friendly visitor;

Maintain confidentiality.

One-on One Support:

Listening and problem solving;

Engaging in prayer;

Participate and support family with activities in the community;

Walk with family on their journey;

Assist the family advocate on their behalf; participate in meetings.
